Secretary report: Leesa moved to approve the February minutes, Janice seconded, members approved. The March minutes were taken by Blaire in Dawn's absence.

Finance report: Savings \$100, Checking \$4004.21, PayPal \$913.61. Total \$5107.82 with checks collected at the meeting to be deposited.

Membership: We have 34 paid members at this time.

Charity quilts update:

- Our 2nd Annual Charity Quilt Challenge was announced, due in November. We reviewed that you receive 1 point for making a quilt top (regardless of when or whether it gets quilted by someone else), 2 points for quilting a quilt, and 1 for binding. We will be adding a prize for the person with the most points at year-end, in addition to 1 or more drawings for prizes from everyone who participates. Prize raffles at December party.

- All charity quilts from last year have been washed and labeled with our new guild QR code labels. There are fragrance-free detergents and color catchers stored with the guild fabric stash if people want to bring their charity quilts washed. Please don't use detergents that have fragrance added.
